NLSD ATA Local #15 Scholarship Policy (Feb. 2012)

1. Purpose

- To recognize the positive outcomes and dedication to life-long learning of graduating NLSD students.

2. Eligibility

- Any NLSD student graduating in June of the current school year, and accepted into an accredited postsecondary program to begin the following September.

- Applications must be received no later than May 1st of the current school year.

3. Application Process

- Applicants must fill out the required application form.

- Applicants must include a copy of their letter of acceptance from their post-secondary program in their application package.

- Applicants must write a personal response to the following topic and submit it with their application:

• Your education has spanned more than a decade. Think of a Northern Lights School Division educator that has made a significant positive impact on your life. Tell us about thisperson and describe the impact they have had on you.

Responses should be no longer than 500 words.

Applicants should return their completed application packages to their school's ATA school rep.
Application packages must be emailed by school ATA reps to their regional key contact, who will forward them to the decision committee before the May 1st deadline.

4. Decision Process

- The committee deciding upon winning applicants will be made up of at least three ATA Local #15 members, with, if possible, at least one from each region: Bonnyville, Cold Lake, and Lac La Biche.

- Judges on the decision committee will choose three winning applicants to receive a scholarship.

- Judges on the decision committee will consider the following in determining the winners:

- Accurate completion of the application form.
- Letter of post-secondary acceptance is present and in good order.
- Personal response follows the instructions as laid out in Section 3.

• Personal response accurately and artfully describes the impact of a specific educator on the life of the applicant.

• Personal response is positive and sincere.

• Personal response is reflective of the applicant's belief in the importance of educators and learning.

• Personal response is well crafted, with care taken to present a letter free of grammar, punctuation and spelling errors.

5. Award

- Each award shall be in the amount of \$1500.00.
- Scholarship to be awarded to winners no later than the last day of the current school year.
- Winning personal responses to be published in the ATA Local #15 June Newsletter.

6. Additional Awards

- Each school in NLSD may grant a scholarship to a student in their school in the amount of \$120.
